Broad-spectrum Sunfilter with SPF23

Due to South Africa's high levels of sunshine, skin cancer and sun-related tumours are a very real possibility. Light-skinned or white-coloured animals are particularly at risk from skin cancer.

What is PetScreen?

PetScreen is a clear liquid sunscreen agent especially developed to protect susceptible animals from the sun. It is packed in a handy pump-spray bottle.

How does PetScreen work?

The four sunscreen agents in PetScreen work together to provide a Sun Protection Factor (SPF) of 23 and give broad-spectrum protection from both UVA (the ultraviolet radiation which damages the skin with more long-term effects) and UVB (the ultraviolet radiation which causes sunburn) components of sunlight.

How do you use PetScreen?

PetScreen should be applied liberally to susceptible areas once daily. For animals that don't like sprays, PetScreen can be sprayed onto a cotton-wool swab and then wiped onto the desired areas.

Precautions

- Do not apply PetScreen to broken skin — if accidental contact should occur, wash with warm water.
- PetScreen must not be used on sensitive areas.

Pack size(s)

100ml spray

Storage

Store in a cool place (below 25°C).



SPF is the amount of time an animal (or person) can be exposed to sunlight before getting sunburn with sunscreen applied relative to the time they can be exposed to sunlight without sunscreen.
